## Need-Based Financial Aid is AVAILABLE

ABL has created a cost structure and instituted a new program, teaching youth how to raise funds through the Raising Capital for Personal Impact and Social Change Program Competition™. This component makes it affordable for underserved and under-resourced students to attend SBLI at little to no tuition cost while making the program available to students of all income levels on a sliding scale. Therefore, all students are encouraged to apply, and to do so as early as possible!

\*The total cost to ABL is \$12,716 per scholar. ABL subsidizes 72.48% (\$9,216) of tuition fees for ALL scholars.

The maximum tuition fee we ask scholars and their families to pay is the **list price** of \$3,500 along with a **non-negotiable and non-refundable commitment and administrative fee** of \$475. Tuition is determined on a sliding scale based on family financial data.

Admitted 2013 SBLI scholars are expected to contribute a non-negotiable and non-refundable commitment fee of \$475 in addition to the assessed final tuition price based on a **sliding scale**. **All students are highly encouraged to apply regardless of financial status since there are no application fees and the commitment fee is not due until a student is accepted into the program and enrolls!**  
**ABL is committed to working with families to make the program accessible and affordable to all admitted scholars.**

### COMPETITIONS

To teach our scholars the importance of working in a group setting, each SBLI scholar will be placed on 2 teams of 3-4 people each.
